





In his words-Andros Rahaman Jimoh

"I have known and lived with endless difficulties. I was born with eye defects which have affected my vision, as I have a twisted cornea. I was born to a Muslim father from Nigeria in bizarre circumstances. My mother was sexually abused, leading to my conception. My father passed away when I was in basic school. The dire conditions I experienced living with my mother made me contemplate suicide on many occasions, **but God has always rescued me.**



The psychological torture my mother has gone through in her life has driven her to become mentally ill and this has affected my education. Her relatives who could come to my aid have all deserted us because of the stigma associated with mental illness and other circumstances surrounding my story.

I do menial jobs to support myself, but this cannot cater for my tuition and upkeep to complete my university education. Heritage Christian College has provided me the environment to build my faith in God and renew my hope in him. It is because of this hope that I continue to pursue my education and trust that God will provide a way for me to finish."



## BE CONSTANT IN PRAYER

Here is a small condensed version of the story that Dr. Twumasi-Ankrah told me while we visited together a few months ago, regarding the need for this truck.



'A few years ago we asked the HBI (Heritage Bible Institute) students, as part of their graduation requirement, to go out into the rural areas of Ghana and plant churches. Within a very short period of time, I had to ask the students to **STOP PLANTING CHURCHES**. Have you ever heard of bible students being asked to STOP planting churches? Our students at HBI were so successful in planting churches, that the faculty and team at HCC/HBI could not keep up with the new increased logistical demands for developing these new churches.'-*as told by Dr. Samuel Twumasi-Ankrah, President of Heritage Christian College in Accra, Ghana.*
