THE HISTORY OF

Heritage Christian College



Heritage Christian College began as a dream project for Dr.
Samuel Twumasi-Ankrah, then a graduate student at Abilene Christian College, in Texas. In 2002, two years after his graduation, Twumasi-Ankrah arranged a partnership with ACU to support the development of HCC, a Christian University to be conceived in Accra, Ghana.

A church member of the Nsawam Road Church of Christ, Twumasi-Ankrah's home congregation in Accra, bought the land that would eventually become HCC's campus, while church members from the United States contributed to breaking ground on the campus' first concrete block buildings. The vision to create the flagship Christian University in Africa was becoming a reality.

In 2009, HCC began the process of seeking accreditation for offering business and bible degrees. In the spring of 2015, HCC was accredited to offer Bachelor's degrees in Theology, Information Technology, as well as five different business administration degrees. The initial freshman class was admitted in the fall of 2015, with expected graduation dates of Spring 2019.

Today, HCC is celebrated as an institution set on exposing students to technologies and learning environments that will prepare them to create their own opportunities, uplift Africa, and become strong, Christian leaders in their communities.


SAMUEL TWUMASI

MAKER LAB

HCC has recently gained access to some pretty amazing, cutting-edge resources, one of which is its very own Maker Lab. Currently, the main attraction of HCC's Maker Lab is its 3D printer. Students have access to the printer and will be encouraged to create a number of items in various programs at HCC.

With HCC's intense focus on entrepreneurship and starting businesses in order to grow Ghana's economy, it's exciting to think about all the possibilities and opportunities that could potentially come out of HCC's Maker Lab. Through HCC's Maker Lab, students have the tools and resources to create things that can affect and benefit the Ghanaian economy.

FARMBOT

The 3D printer isn't the only device that places HCC on the technological cutting-edge. In 2017, the college received another amazing resource, which will greatly expand the scope of the Maker Lab. This device is called FarmBot, humanity's first open-source farming robot.

FarmBot will expose students to using innovative digital technology in farming. Agriculture is critical to growing Ghana, and with this technology, it can be optimized and made simpler with little human input.

HCC hopes that students will use FarmBot as more than just a learning tool, but also as a tool to aid in food sovereignty and entrepreneurship.

Agriculture is extremely important for Ghana's economy and is also an interest of many HCC students.


