A technology enabled campus

Every student, faculty member and administrator will be required to have a laptop, lifetime email, access to a secure electronic filing cabinet on campus and students will be taught how to create, maintain and use an electronic portfolio (e-portfolio). An e-portfolio is an enhanced Curriculum Vita (CV).

HCC will employ many tools and techniques not commonly seen in a university or college. They include:

- HCC Dream Competition Prize winners will be encouraged to progress with the business or community idea and potentially will be invited to develop the idea in the HCC Incubator.
- HCC Incubator The within which a startup business or organization (entity) can begin.
- HCC Campus Center Store(s) HCC will have a campus center which will house stores that can sell products and services of need to students, faculty and the local community.
- HCC Investment Institute will be establishing a portfolio to be used as an investment teaching tool. Students will nominate and agree on a



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non-profit cause to which they will allocate a donation from the returns (ROI).

- HCC Farming Institute will developing vertical business entities (i.e. businesses that take product from farm all the way to consumer). There are several candidates being studied and developed already.
- HCC Technical Training Center The Technical Institute will run its own programs where necessary but will first look to others already doing training and work to nominate and bring students to the training.
- Heritage Bible Institute HBI provides practicum experiences in ministry that will help Church of Christ Bible majors to complete their required training to be ministers in churches of Christ.
- **HCC Clinic** –HCC needs to be able to provide initial care when a student becomes ill. Essentially triage. Over time, the HCC Clinic will provide services to the community.
- HCC Post-Graduate Education Center will provide ongoing training for its graduates.
