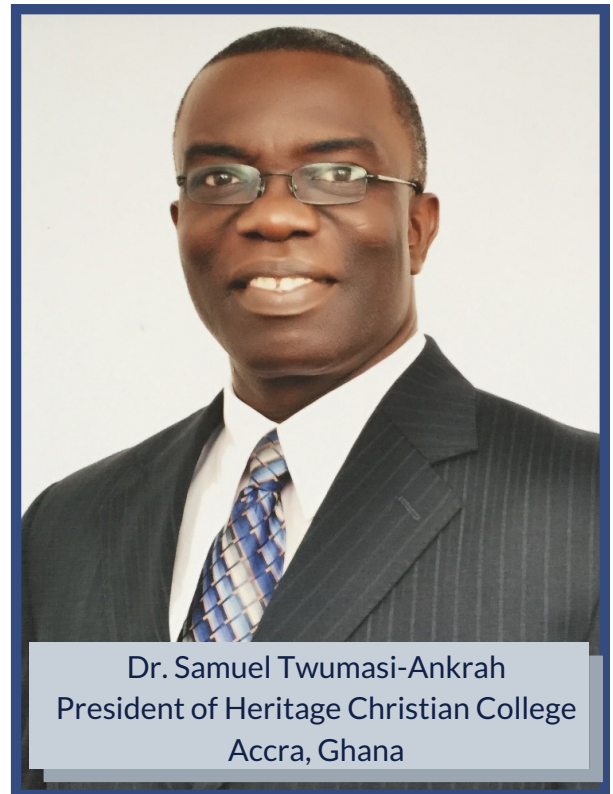

were asked to go home after the government announced a closure of schools. Due to the fact that all our students have their own computers, we are still able to hold online classes, so thankfully our academic calendar has not been disrupted. The main challenges with the online classes are poor connection for those students in rural areas and also data to keep up with the video sessions.

About 10 students who couldn't go home before the lockdown are on campus and they are able to cook their own food or buy from a vendor nearby. All precautionary measures are being maintained.
