The need for student scholarships has always been a focus of ours, and now more than ever, it is an enormous concern to the administration at HCC. As a result of this economic impact, hundreds of our students will not be able to enroll in the next semester until their balances have been reduced. It is for this very reason that we are reaching out to you to ask you to consider being part of the solution to this growing problem. The average amount that is currently past due per student is \$500. This is truly an **EMERGENCY SITUATION**. We pray that you will partner with us by committing to pay off the tuition balance of just one of our students. This financial help will enable hundreds of students with past due balances to continue their education and fulfill their dreams of becoming graduates of Heritage Christian College.
